## I

The name of this corporation is **FAMILIES UNITED FOR PRISON REFORM**.

## II

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit **PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATION** and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for **public** purposes.
- B. The specific purpose of this corporation is increase public safety and reduce crime and violence both within the State's prison system and outside in society by informing, educating, and uniting families and friends of prisoners, and seeking to promote legislation which focuses primarily upon prison reform and rehabilitation programs which will, in turn, further the common good and general welfare of the people of the community.



This corporation is organized and operated for **social welfare** purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(4), Internal Revenue Code.

This property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to **social welfare** purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision of payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for **charitable** purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code.
